a) OlyCap Partnership

Geoff Crump, Exective Director of OlyCap (Olympic Community Action Programs) was present to discuss the possibilities of partnership between OlyCap and the PUD to address consumer protection policies, low-income programs, benefits and energy education. c) Budget 2014 Overview

A Budget Overview Workshop has been set for August 27, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. in the District Chimacum Road office. Draft 2014 Budget is to be on file on September 1, 2013 with public hearing scheduled for October 7, 2013 and provision to Jefferson County in November, 2013.

d) Fair AAR (After Action Review)

Attendance at the PUD No. 1 booth at the Jefferson County Fair was considered to be positive and busy. Planning is in progress for attendance at the September 21, 2013 Quilcene Fair.

MANAGER'S REPORT/OLD BUSINESS

Electrical Summary

The project with Magnum Power, LLC for a new circuit along Beaver Valley Road has been completed. The Electrical Superintendent and staff continue to address transformers in Port Ludlow, emergency management, vegetation plan and net metering. Billing is currently on schedule with the combination of water and electrical service in one statement. There have been some shut-off notices sent. Responses have begun regarding net metering with approximately 2/3 of expected returns received.. Pole hanging policy and agreement continues to be addressed. Regarding agreement with Port Townsend Paper Corporation, meeting with Clallam PUD is imminent regarding transmission transfer. With regard to financing, the additional request for Rural Utilities Services funding has been forwarded by the District to Washington, D.C. and the District Finance Director is preparing a Request for Proposals for a financial accounting software system.

The next CAB meeting is scheduled for September 9, 2013, 1:30 p.m., at the District's Four Corners' office.
