A RESOLUTION ordering the TRANSFER of an Assessment on the Assessment Roll of Local Utility District No.3

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2006-010 ordered the Transfer of an Assessment on the Assessment Roll of Local Utility Disrtict No. 3 by Transfering an Assessment against Parcel #977100605 in the name of Steven Sneed to Parcel #001301003, also in the name of Steven Sneed for the purpose of a lot split requiring the Original Assessment plus the Transferred Assessment of Resolution 2006-010; and

WHEREAS, the property owner was denied the lot split by Jefferson County and is no longer in need of a Second Assessment on Parcel #001301003; and

WHEREAS, the property owner is selling Parcel #001301003 along with the original Assessment for one water service connection; and

WHEREAS, Steven Sneed requests in writing to transfer the paid-in-full, Second Assessment from Parcel #001301003 to Parcel # 001301037, both in the Local Utility District #3, prior to close of escrow; and

WHEREAS, the property owners of the said properties one and the same Steven Sneed, and the purchaser of Parcel #001301003 have been appropriately notified that the Assessment shall be transferred unto the property in the manner authorized by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the District finds and determines that being a paid-in-full Assessment, such transfer does not jeopardize the security or obligations of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the District having considered all things relating to such proposed transfer, has determined that a transfer shall be made on the transfer to the Original Assessment Roll in the manner hereinafter described;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMMISSION OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

The Water Tap Assessment, as levied, paid in full and confirmed against Parcel #001301003 as previously Transferred from Parcel #977100605 appearing on the Final Assessment Roll for Local Utility District No. 3, more specifically described as S30, T30N, R1W, Tax 33 shall be Transfered to Parcel #001301037, more specifically described as S30, T30N, RiW, Tax 31.
