## RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 001

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners setting the District Resource Manager's Compensation

WHEREAS, the Resource Manager is a salaried employee of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Manager's current annual salary of \$51,038.39 was set in June of 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Manager is subject to the same standards and compensation as other PUD employees as defined in the PUD's Personnel Manual adopted the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June 1992 and amended on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of January 1996 and 23<sup>rd</sup> of October, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Union contract directs that employee salaries be increased by 100% of the Seattle Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, based on the average of the July1 to June 30 index which were: .046 (2008), .043 (2009), .022 (2010) and .003 (2011) or a total increase of 11.84%; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Manager's duties have continued to expand as the result of the PUD's voter approved authorization to acquire the electrical facilities in Jefferson County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the PUD Resource Manager salary be increased to \$57,100.00 per year to take into account the COLA increases of the past 4 years.

ADOPTED by the Commission of the Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County, Washington, at a regular open public meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2011.
