A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County, Washington amending the time for application of low income Seniors.

WHEREAS, RCW 54.24.080 provides the rates and charges shall be fair and nondiscriminatory, except as authorized in RCW 74.38.070; and

WHEREAS, RCW 74.38.070 states that PUDs may provide such services at reduced rates for senior low-income citizen or other low-income citizens as defined by a resolution adopted by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Citizen Advisory Board recommended that the PUD Board of Commissioners expand their low income program to serve all eligible low income PUD customers; and

WHEREAS, the PUD Board of Commissioners desires to extend the reduced rates to all eligible PUD low income electrical, water, and sewer customers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

Currently approved PUD low-income Seniors who were automatically moved into the new PUD low income Senior Reduced rate program and are subject to the terms of the new program will need to apply for continued enrollment within one year and two months from the effective date of Resolution 2017-002.

Enrollment will expire May 24, 2018 unless customers have applied for continued enrollment.

All other potential participants may apply for enrollment subject to the terms of the new PUD program.

This program is subject to continued approval of funding by the PUD and may be discontinued by the PUD.Board of Commissioners at any time by Resolution of the Commission.
